


## English

Our class book is *Mystery of the Egyptian Scroll*. Zet and Kat try to save the day in order to save their family market stall. The chase leads them into forbidden temples whispering with the voices of ancient gods, into a web that threatens to crush their family forever.



Our writing will begin with traditional tales with a twist. We will re-write the story of

Cinderella set during the Egyptians. Later in the term we will write information texts about the Ancient Egyptians.

Through our grammar lessons, we will further develop our knowledge of inverted commas and we will begin to learn about fronted adverbials.

## Maths

We will begin by focusing on number. We will be learning written methods for multiplication and division. To further develop our calculation skills, we will be applying our skills to a range of reasoning and problem-solving tasks. Later in the term we will be learning about shape.

Throughout the term we will be practising our mental multiplication skills through fast maths. The focus will be placed on the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.

## Topic

This term we will be learning about life during the ancient civilisation of the Egyptians. We will begin by placing the Ancient Egyptians on a timeline of other key historical events that the children have learned about to date, and we will consider how we know about the past and what it is impossible to find out about.

During the topic we will learn about the importance of the River Nile, pyramids, Pharaohs (including Tutankhamun and Cleopatra), mummification, hieroglyphics and gods and goddesses.



## Science

Our science topic will be 'Animals including Humans'. We will learn the names of important bones, the purpose of the skeleton and how muscles work.



The children will learn that humans cannot make their own food so get

nutrition from what they eat and they will develop their knowledge of a balanced diet, including learning about the five food groups.

## RE

RE will focus on the big question 'Why is the Bible so important for Christians today?' The children will learn about the Bible and its role in Christianity.

## Art and DT

In Design and Technology, the children will investigate the history of bread. They will then taste a range of breads, evaluating the appearance, smell, taste and texture. Finally the children will take part in the Great (Egyptian) Bread Bake Off!

## Music

In Music, we will be exploring texture, dynamics, the harmonic minor scale and graphic scores. We will create our own music in response to stimuli associated with Ancient Egypt.

## Computing

In computing the children will be working on programming through coding. We will be creating games using the programme Scratch (this is downloadable at home too!)

## PSHE

PSHE will focus on getting on and falling out through the study of the big question 'Why do I sometimes feel angry?' We will also look at differences and diversity through the question 'Should boys cry?'

## French

In French, we will build our confidence with greetings and personal description, moving on to the topic of animals.

## PE

Gymnastics will continue to be the focus of our PE lessons this term.
