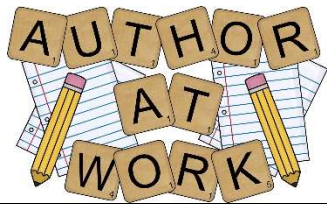


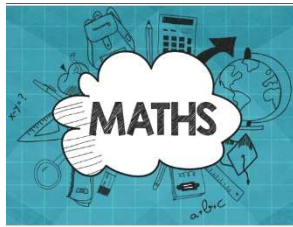
English

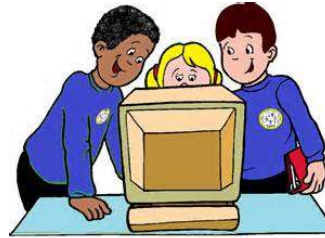
PE
