








<p>English</p> <p>The children will be developing their speaking and listening skills through activities with a talking partner and through small group activities and games with a grown up.</p> <p>During our phonic sessions the children will be making and identifying different sounds. They will be developing blending skills so that they can hear the sounds in a word and then blend the sounds together and say the word.</p> <p>They will be matching letters to sounds and spelling words using magnetic letters,</p> <p>The children will be developing their pencil control and the skills needed to form letters.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>During maths lessons the children will be learning to count, recognise and order numbers 1-5, 1-10 and 1-20. The children will be learning to subitize which is recognising the patterns on dice, dominoes and five frames.</p> <p>The children will be solving simple problems using the language of more, fewer and the same to compare and describe sets of objects. There will be opportunities for the children to create patterns, pictures and models using different shapes. We will be learning to recognise and name shapes.</p>	<p>Autumn Term 1 Class - Reception Topic-New Beginnings Class Book We're Going on a Bear Hunt.</p> 	<p>RE</p> <p>During our Religious Education lessons the children will be finding out about people who are special to us at home and at school. There will be opportunities for the children to talk about their special person and draw pictures of them.</p> <p>The children will be finding out why we celebrate Harvest Festival. We will be exploring the school garden and using the harvest produce in our cooking.</p> 	<p>The World</p> <p>The children will be exploring their new learning environment. We will be learning in the indoor and outdoor classrooms. They will use vegetables from our school garden to cook muffins and make soup. The children will be observing the changes that occur when food is cooked. During our focus learning sessions the children will be using their senses to explore different fruits and vegetables. There will be opportunities to touch, taste and smell different foods.</p> 
<p>Art and D&T</p> <p>The children will have opportunities to work with different materials and techniques.</p> <p>They will use printing skills to create pictures and patterns. The children will also learn how to mix different colours using the paint.</p> <p>During learning through play the children can access the workshop area to create their own models and pictures.</p> 	<p>Music</p> <p>The children will be learning counting songs, turn taking songs, harvest songs and songs to help learn the names of the other children in the class.</p> <p>The children will be using simple instruments to tap out rhythms and keep a simple beat.</p> <p>We will be playing games with the class Beat Baby to develop our skill of keeping a steady beat.</p> 	<p>Computing</p> <p>The children will be introduced to simple programmable robot toys called "Bee Bots". They will be learning to make the Bee Bots move forwards, backwards and turn.</p> <p>The children will learn to control a mouse and create simple pictures on a computer.</p> 	<p>PSHE</p> <p>During our circle time activities the children will explore our school values. The children will be finding out about how they can demonstrate the values during our daily activities in the indoor and outdoor classrooms.</p> <p>The children will be using their treasure boxes to support them in talking about what is important to them.</p> 	<p>PE</p> <p>During PE lessons the children will be learning to move in different ways safely in the hall. The children will be learning to follow instructions and take turns with the equipment. There will be opportunities for the children to develop their core body strength. They will engage in activities such as balancing, moving to music and jumping on and off PE equipment.</p>
