


<p>English</p> <p>The children will be continuing to develop their segmenting and blending skills to read words. The children will be learning to write simple sentences that can be read by others. There will be regular opportunities for the children to develop accurate letter formation. The children will have opportunities to create their own stories.</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>The children will be learning about what each digit in a two digit number represents. The children will be using ten frames and numicon to develop an understanding of place value. The children will be solving simple number problems and explaining their ideas. Shapes will be used to create patterns, pictures and models. The children will be learning to name and describe 2D and 3D shape.</p> 	<p>Spring Term 2 Class - Reception Topic-How do we know if a character is a villain in a story?</p> 	<p>RE</p> <p>The children will be finding out about places that are special to them in school and places that are special to their family. We will be finding out about special Christian celebrations such as Shrove Tuesday, Mothering Sunday and Easter.</p> 	<p>The World</p> <p>During the next few weeks we will be finding out about spring weather and looking for signs of spring in the outdoor area. The children will be planning and making dens for wolves using different materials such as junk modelling boxes, bricks and duplo. The children will be evaluating their wolf dens and thinking about how they could improve their models.</p> 
<p>Art and D&T</p> <p>Different media will be used to create characters for the stories of Red Riding Hood and Peter and the Wolf. The children will develop skills of painting, collage, and sewing. During the day the children will have opportunities to create their own models and pictures using the resources in the workshop area. The children will be developing cutting, drawing, collage and painting skills.</p> 	<p>Music</p> <p>The children will be listening to the musical story of Peter and the Wolf. Each character in the story is represented by a different instrument. The children will be finding out about the different instruments and the characters they represent. The children will be making their own musical shakers. We will be learning songs about spring and accompanying them with our shakers.</p> 	<p>Computing</p> <p>The children will use a simple music making program to create music to represent the characters for the stories of Red Riding Hood and Peter and the Wolf. During this topic the children will use 2Simple publishing to create speech bubbles for the different characters.</p> 	<p>PSHE</p> <p>During our circle time lessons the children will be thinking about what they like. The children will be using their treasure boxes to find objects that are similar and different. We will be playing games to develop listening and attention in a small group. The children will have opportunities to speak and share their ideas as part of a group.</p> 	<p>PE</p> <p>During PE lessons the children will have opportunities to balance, cross crawl and make different body shapes. They will develop simple sequences of movement and experiment with moving to different types of music. Each day the children will be running, hopping and walking outside to develop stamina and fitness.</p>
