





<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>The children will begin the term focusing on narratives and in particular their description of setting, characters and plot. They will then continue to focus on speech before looking at how they can extend and improve their sentences. The children will be exploring the use of apostrophes in detail and applying these to their work. The children will continue their daily reading session with the initial focus being inference. They will also continue their spelling sessions three times per week.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>In Maths, we will begin by exploring the formal calculations for multiplication and division. This will be closely linked to their times table work throughout the term. We will be focusing on our 6, 7, 8 &amp; 9 times tables in particular. The children will begin to understand the difference between solid, liquid and gases and the changes that occur when they are heated or cooled. Over the unit of work the children will also be exploring evaporation and condensation before linking it to the process of the water cycle.</p>
