

English

A mysterious boat has sailed into our classroom... It will guide us to imaginary places near and far!

The texts we will read this half term are all linked to islands and the ocean. We will also examine some well-known poetry titles like the 'The Owl and the Pussycat'.

Linking to our reading, in writing sessions we will create new stories, write letters, describe settings and characters and finish by writing reports.

Spelling, punctuation and grammar work will focus on different sentence types and the related punctuation (.,!?), use of the correct tense, plurals and revise when to use apostrophes.

Phonics will continue daily and we will look at using our syllable knowledge to help with spelling longer words.

Maths



This half term we will continue working on calculating using all four operations. We will develop both our mental and written calculations. Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problem solving will be worked upon. Some of these tasks will be linked to money and measures work.

FAST maths focus on inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and then multiplication and division.

Position and direction work will be directly linked to our map work in topic.

Topic

In science we will look at plants, and complete different investigations to explore germination as well as the best ways to keep plants healthy.

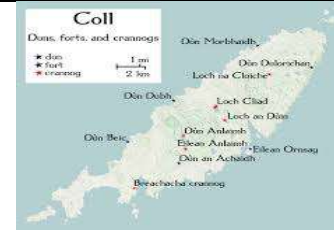
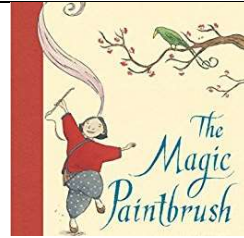
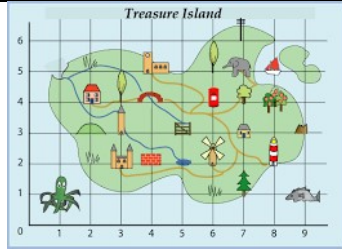
We will start off by looking at a range of seeds and learn how they disperse. We will design new seeds using this knowledge.
