






<p><b>English</b></p> <p>The children will begin their English work studying the Roman myth of Romulus and Remus. We will look at the structure and message from the myth and begin to create our own.</p> <p>The children will begin by focusing on their basic grammar skills before exploring speech punctuation and expanded noun phrases throughout their writing.</p>  <p>We will also begin by looking at the Autumn reading and spelling words for the term.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Our first topic in Maths will be place value. We will be partitioning, ordering and round numbers up to 10,000 and discussing the value of each digit in a number. The children will also be able to find 10, 100 and 1000 more or less than a number. Throughout this topic the children will continue to work on their fluency, reasoning and problem solving.</p> <p>Each day the children will have an activity relating to times tables, as these need to be continually practiced and learned throughout the year.</p>	<p><b>Autumn Term 1</b> <b>Class 4</b></p> <p><b>The Romans are Coming...</b></p>  <p><b>Class Book:</b> <b>Romans on the Rampage</b> <b>Written by Jeremy Strong</b></p> 	<p><b>Topic</b></p> <p>Year four will be focusing on the Romans during this half term. We will be learning about the Roman empire and the impact it had on Britain. We will also explore Roman settlements to understand how the Romans used land.</p>  <p><b>RE</b></p> <p>In RE, we will be exploring the creation story and in particular we will be answering the question 'What do Christians learn from the creation story?'</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>This term, we will be focusing on the digestive system, teeth and food chains. The children will explore how food is digested, the importance of oral hygiene and the effect on teeth. Finally, covering the importance of food chains. The children will carry out different investigations throughout the topic and this will link with our food and nutrition topic in D&amp;T.</p> <p><b>French</b></p> <p>Building on French learning from last year, we will be describing personalities and emotions, and learning vocabulary for parts of the body. We will also start to learn numbers from 21-50.</p>
<p><b>D&amp;T</b></p> <p>We will be covering food and nutrition in D&amp;T which will link to this terms Science topic. The children will make use of the vegetables in the school garden to create a Roman broth.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Music will tie in with the Roman topic. We will listen to and compose some marches, and sing songs in Latin – the language of the Romans</p> 	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>Throughout the term the children will be focusing on the importance of online safety. They will use a range of multimedia projects to make posters and presentations relating to online safety.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>This term, we will be discussing two questions. The first question will be 'Why do we have to have rules?' Before we begin our Going for goals topic exploring the question 'I find it hard to concentrate, what can I do?'</p>	<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>Year 4 will begin their year by learning the basics of the sport Handball. We will link the defending aspects to our Roman topic as we learn to 'invade' the opponent's goal area.</p>
