English

This term the children will be creating incident reports and narratives around our class book. Within grammar, the children will be focusing on speech punctuation, the effective use of paragraphs and the accurate use of verb inflictions within a sentence. The children will continue to work through the year 3/4 spellings, while regularly using a dictionary to help support their spelling work.



D&T

This term, we will be focusing on our linkages and levers in D&T. They will create a project over the term.

Maths

In Maths, we will cover a range of different topics. We will begin by covering our geometry unit. Year four will explore the properties of different shapes before learning about symmetry of shapes.

The children will then focus on position and direction using coordinates to alter the position of shapes.

Year four will conclude with the statistics unit that will focus on the interpretation of tables and graphs which will link with our computing topic this term.


Music
