Within grammar, the children will be focusing on speech punctuation, the effective use of paragraphs and the accurate use of verb inflections within a sentence. The children will continue to work through the year 3/4 spellings, while regularly using a dictionary to help support their spelling work.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths, we will cover a range of different topics. We will begin by covering our geometry unit.
