


<p>English</p> <p>We are starting this term by writing a biography about Matthew Henson as we learnt about his achievements last term.</p> <p>Next we will move onto to writing our own story based on a Greek Myth. We will begin by continuing our work on multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We will then use these skills when we learn about decimals; particularly tenths and hundredths.</p>	<p>Summer Term 1</p> <p>Class – 5</p> <p>Ancient Greece</p> <p>Class Book:</p>  <p>Hugh Lupton</p>	<p>Topic</p> <p>Our topic this term is <i>Ancient Greece</i>.</p> <p>We will be delving into the world of <i>Ancient Greece</i>, firstly understanding where it was and which other periods were around at the same time. We will then look at the differences between Athens and Sparta and use artefacts to interpret what life was like in the past. Finally, we will find out what we have to thank the <i>Ancient Greeks</i> for; what features of their society have survived today.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>We will be continuing our work on <i>Living Things</i>. We have caterpillars which we will look after and watch them develop into chrysalis and finally butterflies. We will dissect a flower to see all the parts involved in plant reproduction. We will learn about sexual and asexual reproduction of plants.</p>
<p>RE</p> <p>This term we are focussing on places of worship across different religions and their purpose to answer the question: <i>If God is everywhere, why do we have places of worship?</i></p>	<p>French</p> <p>Pupils will be learning the vocabulary for wild animals.</p>			
<p>Art and D&T</p> <p>Pupils we learn about different types of artwork beginning with mosaics, then pointillism and abstract art. Pupils will practise this skills then work towards a piece of their own using the techniques as inspiration.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Pupils will be learning about <i>Ancient Greek</i> influence in music, using typical patterns in artwork to influence our own compositions.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Pupils are learning how to create a podcast about <i>Greek Gods</i>. This will involve planning and scripting their podcast, recording it and transferring the data over to a computer to edit together.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>We will be focusing on <i>Being Responsible</i>. This unit teaches the pupils to be aware of people human rights and how we have a responsibility to help others. We will also be learning about democracy and how parliament works.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>We will be working on our <i>Health and Social cog</i> in Real PE.
